



## Year of the Eucharist resources for grades k-5



**The Eucharist for Little Children** (*Wild Canary Sights and Sounds*; 20 minutes) Through the use of song, prayer and

story, host Jennifer Naimo helps young children understand the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and explains how they can best honor Him.


dramatizations of stories from scripture and questions to the "Holy Heroes Answer Kid" reveal how the Old Testament stories of Moses and the Exodus prefigure the New Testament accounts of Jesus' Last Supper. The program also looks at the development of the Mass and at Eucharistic piety through bonus features about Adoration, Exposition and Benediction.


**Understanding Sunday Mass: A Kid's Point of View** (*Anchor Productions*, 2011; 40 minutes) Fr.

Jerry gives Amanda and AJ a unique tour of Sunday Mass. Through the use of a "remote control", Fr. Jerry is able

to stop and start the Mass to instruct his two young friends about the order of the Mass, the roles of participants in the Mass, symbols and gestures, the priest's vestments and objects in the sanctuary. The program is divided into two twenty minute sections to help keep student's attention and to allow teachers an opportunity for review. Also available in Spanish.




**The Bread of Life: Celebrating the Eucharist** (*Herald Entertainment*; 29 minutes) Through story and song, Brother Francis teaches young children about the Sacrament of the Eucharist.




Viewers will see animated presentations of the Last Supper and the Life of Blessed Imelda Lambertini, the patroness of


**The Holy Eucharist** (*Holy Heroes*, 2013; 60 minutes) teaches viewers about the Real Presence of Christ. Puppet shows,



**The Mass: A Life-Giving Prayer** (*Herald Entertainment*, 2014; 25 minutes) This episode with Brother Francis includes: a celebration of the Mass; "With a Heart of Praise" (a song of gratitude); and the story of the Pharisee and the Publican. English and Spanish.



**Kids and the Sacraments: Communion** (*Paraclete Press*, 2013; 13 minutes) Segments in this program include explanations from Father Ken Overbeck, interviews with kids, storyboard Bible teaching, and an "on the road" field trip to explore in depth where the altar bread comes from.



**The Mass for Children and Young People** (*St Anthony Messenger Press*) includes three programs: The Mass for Older children (grades 4-8, 13 minutes); Mass for Younger Children (grades 1-3, 20 minutes); Why Do We Go to Mass on Sunday? (grades 2-5, 12 minutes).
